Boats up to 26'- [Sunday, Oct. 23rd](#)

Boats 27' & over - [Wednesday, Oct. 12th \(Crane Day\)](#)

Work Order Deadline- [Sunday, October 2nd](#)

****Work orders must be received by the date above to properly schedule labor and materials and guarantee services.**

*If you plan to haul your boat yourself and do not need it shrink wrapped, the deadline is the 23rd, regardless of size.

Dillon Hosts the Highest Triathlon in the World



The Town of Dillon is hosting its first ever triathlon in early September. The 106 West Triathlon consists of a 1.2 mile swim in Dillon Reservoir, a 56 mile bike course (2 loops) on the roadways above, and a 13.2 mile run (2 loop course) on the Summit County Recreational Pathway system, from Dillon Marina to Heaton Bay Campground, finishing at Dillon Marina.

The Dillon Marina is base camp for the event, which as you can imagine, will create some serious parking and access impacts around the marina that day as well as the days surrounding the event.
