**CALL TO ORDER**

The regular meeting of the PRAC Committee of the Town of Dillon, Colorado, was held on Monday, June 7, 2021, by electronic participation through the Microsoft Teams application. Interim Chair, Eric Nicholds, called the meeting to order at 5:06 pm. Committee members present were Mimi Motahari and Lucinda Burns. Staff members present were Scott O'Brien; Public Works Director, Staff Liaison, Karen Kaminski, Town Council, and Michelle Haynes, Recording Secretary.

**APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF MAY 3, 2021, REGULAR MEETING**

The approval of the June 3, 2021, meeting minutes were moved to the following meeting because there was not an adequate quorum in attendance.

**NEW BUSINESS (Public Hearing)**

Scott O'Brien: Public Works Director, reviewed the Bonnie Boex Memorial with Committee members present. Scott read a letter in favor of the Memorial from Committee Member, Louis Skowyra. Tyler Johnson, Denver Water made a brief presentation on what the Water Board would like to see regarding a memorial for Bonnie. Tyler agreed a memorial bench or plaque would be best. Discussion of caring for the birds and resources needed will happen in the future with Carolyn Skowyra.

Scott O'Brien presented a Memorial Day Recap to the PRAC Committee. Scott presented the idea of moving the Ceremony to the Amphitheater in future and the committee was in favor of the idea. This discussion will happen again when the whole Committee is present.

Scott O'Brien presented Town Park Master Plan Phase 1 Improvement Schedule and gave a Town Construction update to the PRAC Committee. The committee had no questions.

**OLD BUSINESS (Public Hearing)**

Scott O'Brien gave an update on the SCoMBA project and discussed the concept of pedestrian walkways from Dillon Valley into Dillon for future conversation.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

Scott Vinas, 615 Piney Acres Circle stood in front of the Committee to express his concerns about a potential walkway from the Piney Acres development to the Dillon Ridge Development. He was informed this is a County decision and he would need to follow up with them.
