OUR GOALS

As the Town of Dillon continues to grow events to support our community, we are dedicated to achieving the goals of event sustainability and zero waste. Over the last few years, we have committed to using sustainable materials and practices to divert waste at our events and our facilities, and we expect our vendor partners to do the same.

WHAT WE EXPECT

- Keep your area clean and tidy. Please pack out any vendor waste.
- Single-use plastics are banned. This includes plastic bags, plastic cutlery, plastic bottles, plastic plates/bowls, and plastic cups.
- Utilize compostable items for food service, ideally those products that are compostable at our local facility.
- When possible, please use reusable items in preparation, creation, and serving.
- Banned items include: styrofoam, plastic straws, stir sticks, individual condiment packages, individually wrapped snacks, foil-lined wrappers, plastic wrap, and aluminum foil.
