



Get ready for the biggest and best “National Marina Day” celebration in the history of the modern world. The event ‘takes flight’ on June 7<sup>th</sup> with the “Air and Water Show” at 1000 hrs. We have obtained a waiver from the FAA to hold the show. The air show performers will be executing precise aerobatic flying close to water level, requiring us to section off a “sterile” area on the reservoir for the safety of both the public and the air show pilots. The picture below displays the area in question. No one will be allowed within 500 feet of this space from approximately 0930 hrs. to 1200 hrs., or until the show is finished. The sterile area will be marked off by boats with orange and white checkered flags.



So, prepare yourselves to be amazed but please comply with the reservoir restrictions during those times. If you choose to be on the water for the show, you will need to leave the dock no later than 0900 hrs. to position yourself outside the closed off area, and will not be able to return until after the show. The launch ramp will be closed as well from 0900 hrs. to 1200 hrs. The shoreline is also a great place to watch the show, giving you the advantage of hearing the announcer. The same “sterile” area may also be closed off on June 6<sup>th</sup> for practice and in celebration of the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary of D Day. Again, the best and quickest way to stay updated is to visit the marina’s website and Facebook pages, where you can get details of dates, times and closures.

After the practice run on June 6<sup>th</sup>, the aircraft will be on static display at the Kremmling airport. The public is welcome to visit and see the aircraft up close and take pictures. There is still the opportunity to volunteer to help with the Air and Water Show. This is a great opportunity to learn about airshow security and the airshow business.
