



Notice of Road closures, Summit Stage impacts and delays for September 10, 2016. Expected closures from 9 am – 2:30 pm.

The 106 West Dillon Triathlon will take place Saturday, September 10, 2016, beginning and ending at Dillon Marina.

The 106 West Triathlon consists of a 1.2 mile swim in Dillon Reservoir, a 56 mile bike course (2 loops) on the roadways below, and a 13.2 mile run (2 loop course) on the Summit County Recreational Pathway system, from Dillon Marina to Heaton Bay Campground, finishing at Dillon Marina.

Please be aware that the streets listed below will be subject to closure and limited access during the time of the race. The expected closure time is 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Streets will open once the last rider has cleared the course.

Please see the details of the course route listed below and the attached course map for your reference:

Course Route/Road Closures:

- W. Lodgepole Street
- Dillon Dam Road from Heaton Bay Campground to Highway 6
- Highway 6 all eastbound lanes to Montezuma Road
- Highway 6 east and west bound traffic located on West bound lanes
- Montezuma Road
- Lake Dillon Drive to Dillon Marina

***Each crossing will be monitored by Dillon Police, Summit County Sheriff or Colorado State Patrol. The only time motorists will be able to cross is when they are directed by an officer. Peak bike traffic will be from 9:30 a.m. – 1 p.m. Please plan accordingly.**

Access points: There will be access/crossing points* from Dillon and Keystone along Highway 6 at the following locations:

- Lake Dillon Drive Elk Drive
- Tenderfoot Street Elk Crossing Lane
- Elk Horn Keystone Road
- Lake Side Drive Rasor Drive

Town of Dillon closures

One way traffic will be available in a loop down Lake Dillon Drive to East LaBonte and out Tenderfoot. Police will direct traffic left or right at the eagle statue on HWY. 6

- West side of Lake Dillon Drive
- W. Lodgepole Street
- LaBonte West of West of Buffalo
- Marina Drive
- Dillon Dam Road

Dillon Valley closures

Exit Little Beaver Trail Only

***Each crossing will be monitored by Dillon Police, Summit County Sheriff or Colorado State Patrol. The only time motorists will be able to cross is when they are directed by an officer. Peak bike traffic will be from 9:30 a.m. – 1 p.m. Please plan accordingly.**

Dillon Ridge and Summit Cove bus stops will be open.

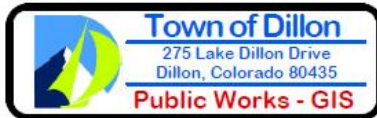
West Bound Elkhorn, Corinthian Hill will be open.

Alternative RecPath route:

While the Rec Path will remain open, flaggers will be stationed to direct people to exit Rec Path onto Dam Road at Heaton Campground during portions of the day. Rec Path users will be directed to LaBonte Street to Marina Place, Rec Path cut through and back on to the Rec Path.

Dillon Marina Closures:

Thursday, September 8th: Marina and Marina Park/Amphitheater parking lots CLOSED all day. Parking will be available to marina slip holders and boat rental/sailing customers on a first come, first-serve basis in the lower marina yard along the waterfront. Additional parking will be available in the overflow lot directly above the marina lot. Marina launch ramp will be CLOSED all day.

Friday, September 9th: Marina and Marina Park/Amphitheater parking lots CLOSED all day. Marina CLOSED for boat rentals. Parking will be available to marina slip holders only on a first come, first-serve basis in the lower marina yard along the waterfront. Additional parking will be available in the overflow lot directly above the marina lot. Marina launch ramp will be CLOSED all day.

Saturday, September 10th: Triathlon Day: Marina and Marina Park/Amphitheater parking lots CLOSED all day. The ONLY parking available will be in the Town lots, above Labonte Street. Foot traffic only down to the marina via recreation path between condos & down single track dirt trail. NO boats will be allowed to leave the docks until after 12:30 pm. Marina launch ramp will be CLOSED all day.

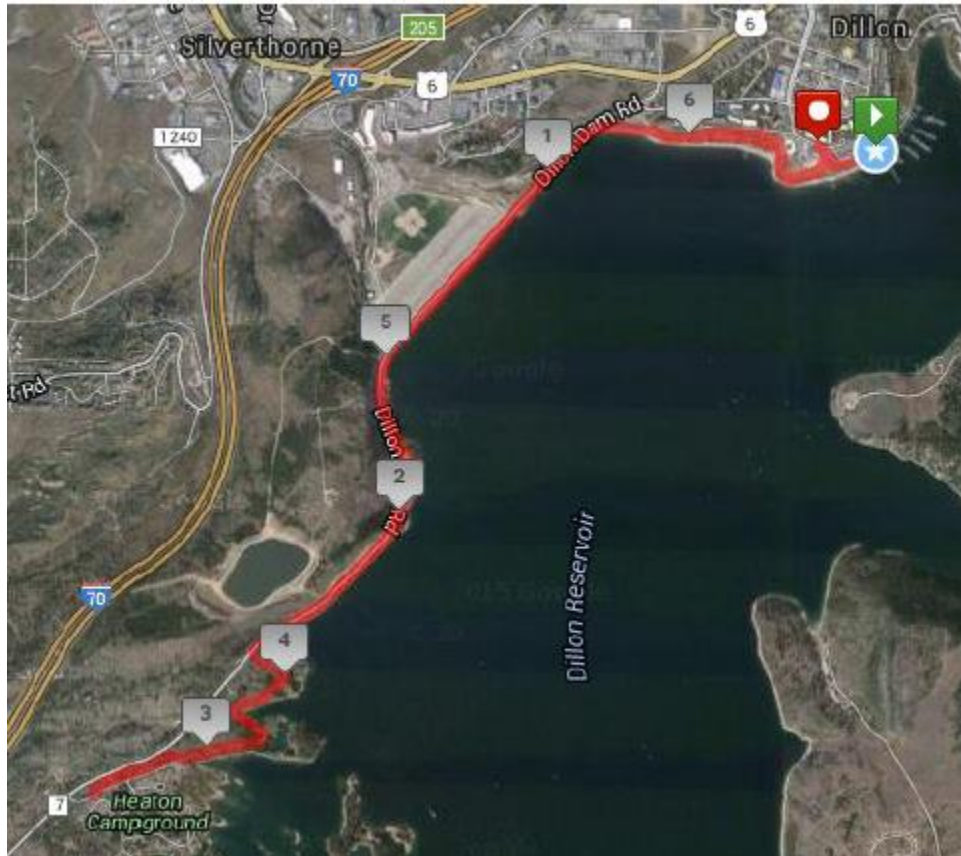
Sunday, September 11th: Triathlon tear down: Marina and Marina Park/Amphitheater parking lots CLOSED until 12:00 pm. Parking will be available to marina slip holders and boat rental/sailing customers on a first come, first serve basis in the lower marina yard along the waterfront. Additional parking will be available in the overflow lot directly above the marina lot. Launch ramp closed until 12:30 pm
